### 398th Mission Formation Chart 20 June 1944 to Hamburg, Germany – Over Target

The Over Target Chart would have these adjustments:

- 1. High Group Turner Element: Ballard A/C 2519-A Ballard returned early (PDF 1559)
- 2. High/Low Group Exchange: In the over target chart, High Group Turner A/C 2599-U exchanges with Falkenback A/C 7190-L in Low Group position # 2 under element leader Hornshuh. This would be as shown over target in PDF 1561 file 480d.

#### **Lead Group:**

- 1. Daily Lead A/C 7686-L was a loan from 324th 91st BG.
- 2. Melmo-Lowe Deputy Group Lead A/C 7594-B was a loan from 324th 91st BG.

## 398<sup>th</sup> Bombardment Group Formation Charts Captain Alan A. Arlin Diary Charts

The preceding 398<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group Formation Chart was included in Captain Alan A. Arlin's Diary. Captain Arlin was in the 398<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group, 601<sup>st</sup> Squadron.

It is believed that Captain Arlin retyped these charts, perhaps from a copy that was handed to the pilots at morning briefing. This judgment is based on a match between the typewriter font for his diary and the formation charts. Occasionally he may have added some information to his charts. In fact, he did add his personal mission number to the lower right hand corner.

His charts are the same or similar to the Planned Formation Chart in the microfilmed 398<sup>th</sup> records and are different than the After Assembly or Over Target Formation Charts. The following list of Captain Arlin's missions can help identify target names for the various Captain Arlin Formation Charts.
