398th Bombardment Group Formation Charts Captain Alan A. Arlin Diary Charts

398th Mission Formation Chart 27 June 1944 to Biennais, France

NOTE: A comparison of the Over Target and the Planned Formation Chart whether in 398th Records (PDF 0544) or Captain Arlin's Chart from his diary show a major difference from the Over Target Formation Chart from 398th Records (PDF 0609). The difference is the elimination of the High Group under Latson in A/C 2469-Q. It appears that perhaps the High Group was just cancelled and Latson flew as Weather Ship instead. See Over Target Chart.

398th Bombardment Group Formation Charts Captain Alan A. Arlin Diary Charts

The preceding 398th Bomb Group Formation Chart was included in Captain Alan A. Arlin's Diary. Captain Arlin was in the 398th Bomb Group, 601st Squadron.

It is believed that Captain Arlin retyped these charts, perhaps from a copy that was handed to the pilots at morning briefing. This judgment is based on a match between the typewriter font for his diary and the formation charts. Occasionally he may have added some information to his charts. In fact, he did add his personal mission number to the lower right hand corner.

His charts are the same or similar to the Planned Formation Chart in the microfilmed 398th records and are different than the After Assembly or Over Target Formation Charts. The following list of Captain Arlin's missions can help identify target names for the various Captain Arlin Formation Charts.
