Captain Alan A. Arlin Diary Charts

398th Mission Formation Chart **5 October 1944 to Cologne, Germany**

There are a number of discrepancies on the Arlin Chart from the official record. It is possible Captain Arlin did not use the correct formation chart for this day when assembling his diary for 5 October or perhaps something else happened that is not in the official record.

Captain Alan A. Arlin Diary Charts

The preceding 398th Bomb Group Formation Chart was included in Captain Alan A. Arlin's Diary. Captain Arlin was in the 398th Bomb Group, 601st Squadron.

It is believed that Captain Arlin retyped these charts, perhaps from a copy that was handed to the pilots at morning briefing. This judgment is based on a match between the typewriter font for his diary and the formation charts. Occasionally he may have added some information to his charts. In fact, he did add his personal mission number to the lower right hand corner.

His charts are the same or similar to the Planned Formation Chart in the microfilmed 398th records and are different than the After Assembly or Over Target Formation Charts. The following list of Captain Arlin's missions can help identify target names for the various Captain Arlin Formation Charts.
