Eye Witness Description of Missing Aircraft B17 G 42-103463 under command of 2nd Lt John K Godwin No-756218, 602nd Bomb Squadron, 398th Bomb Group on Toulouse, France mission 25 June 1944.

I was the top turret operator in It griffin's plane (the lead ship). Several seconds after dropping the bombs I swung the turret around to approximately 0800. There was a BITG on fire. The plane was climbing very steeply and seemed to be under control. The number four engine nacelle seemed to be all on fire and flame was flying back to the tail. A few seconds before stalling one man parachuted out the tail excape hatch. The ship started down in a steep dive. There two men came out of the waist door. One chute opened immediately and one fell possibly five thousand feet before apening chutes. The ship was still diving when another man came out the nose escape hatch and another out the waist. I did not see the latter open his chute as two more men came out. I couldn't see which end of plane but I never saw one chute open et all. After that the plane seemed to level off and circle very sharpely. I saw no more men leave the plane. After circling about one time the ship went into a dive. It was still diving when it hit the ground and exploded.)

Eye Witness Description of Missing Aircraft B17G 42-102463 under command of 2nd Lt John K Godwin, JeO-756218, 602nd Bomb Squadron, 398th 30mb Group on Toulouse, France mission 25 June 1944.

I saw the skip number 463, which was piloted by it Godwin, get a direct hit in the supercharger of number four engine. He was flying left wing to Lt Hough. This was just a few seconds after bombs away. Fire broke out right away in the right wing. He peeled out of the formation to the left and I saw the tail gunner go out first and then one waist gunner. The ship then went into a dive and two more chutes came out followed by three more. The pilot pulled the ship out of the dive for a few seconds and the last two chutes came out. It then went into a slow spin and one wing came off. The ship never exploded until it hit the ground.

We were over the target when I first noticed that ship number \$18, (which was flown by Lt Godwin) was hit. Number three engine was smoking end then started flaming. They circled two times and I saw seven parachutes, then the number three engine exploded and it dived, nose first, to the ground and hit; burning a short distance from the target.))




