V. Remarks:

The middle part of the iuselage lies west of Liebschwitz railway-station in the Elster river, the left wing and I engine lies at Dauben-Preskeln, another engine lies close to the railway-tra cks Gera-Weiden between the highway and the roadbed, about 200 m maxicalrishingums from this spot west of the highway lies the right wing. About 200 m to the north on the bank of the Elster river lies the third engine, the fourth engine to the east near Liebschwitz railway-station in the ditch close to the railroad-crossing. 800 m to the north between the Elster river and the railway-tracks is the front part of the fuselage lying 600 m northwest of this fragment are the tail assembly with tail-turret.

The six prisoners were housed in the Reuss-permanent barracks, I dend was recovered from out of the Elster river, for the other dead was intently searched among the debris, but without any success. On 9 July 44 he was found dead in a wheatfield and reported to this post by the garrison commander of Gera. A serious casualty was delivered to "Waldkrankenhaus" Gera through men of the administrative services. He is not fit for transportation.

Members of Army search detachments emptied the pockets of the prisoners and the dead without making a list of what they took. Furthermore identification tags and engine-plates were taken away, through nobody knows which group did it, though. Detachments of the Army and of the attiaircraft-defense were supposedly seen at the spots where the debris are lying. Members of the Army took away private money and escaping funds from the prisoners.



I heard our pilot say over the interphone that a ship had been hit at nine c'clock. Then I heard our waist gunner say a wing had come off and was coming by. I looked out of the tail position toward nine o'clock where I saw a wing float by with one motor still intact. This hammened about one or two minutes after the bombs had been drop ed.

I didn't see the actual explosion, but after the wing went by quite a few parts also came by. I didn't notice the rest of the ship until about five minutes later after a turn to the right where I saw the trail smoke. I caught sight of the ship just before it hit in a large wooded area. This area seemed to be left and a few miles from the target. That would be about Southwest of the target.

I counted five chutes floating down after we had gone a little way. I counted them two or three times to make sure I was right. They must have been about four thousand feet below us at the time I counted them. They were closely grouped so they probably landed close together.

The middle part of the fuselage lies west of Liebschmits reliver-station in the Elster river, the left wing and I engine lies at Leuben-Preakeln, snother engine lies alose to the reliver-tre oke Gera-Weiden between the highes y and the reached, about 200 m maximum this against from this spot west of the highes y lies the right wing. About 200 m to the north on the bank of the Flator river lies the third engine, the fourth engine to the east near indexchalts reliverstation in the ditch close to the relived-crossing. 500 m to the north between the Elster river and the reliver-tracks is the front part of the fuselage lying 600 m northwest of this fragment are the tell assembly with tell-turret.
