

After thorough investigation bodies belonging to 3 men of the were recovered at the place of crash (distr. Kinzigtal, village, Kinterheubach, Blaulich) of the downed 4-engined USA Bomber on July 16, 1944. Recovery was done by the community of Kinzigtal, in presence of the undersigned rural police-man of Schiltach. The dog-tags of Adead could only be found. The third crew-member could be identified only by small parts of a body belonging to a third person definitely. As far as possible, personal property of each dead was kept separatly and put on a roster. Lists are enclosed in triplicate. Contents of bag 1 and 3 had been found apart but supposedly belong together as parts of body were missing. These had been found with the contents of bag 3 in the vicinity of the corpse and were recognized as belonging to it. The names of the identified dead are:

- 1) Robert C. Warkentin ASN 39689358 T43-44 O P bags #1 and 3
- 2) Charles B. Mc Lean ASN 14102259 T42-43 A bag # 2

The dead were buried on the cemetery of St. Roman, community Kinzigtal.

The personal property of the dead was wrapped in bags and sealed and will be handed over to airbase Hqts. Freiburg by messenger Cpl. Heinrick Griebel upon signing.



Over target the weather was very bad, caused from contrails. After leaving target visibility cleared up. About forty minutes out from the target and ME-109 came from about twelve o'clock high and swept over the formation. There were quite a few bursts of twenty MM shells bursting. Then from about five o'clock from our tail was three 109's. The first one came up and fired. That was when I saw Lt Gallagher's ship get hit. I noticed a hole in the left wing and a small fire. The ball gunner's door was blown off and he looked to be hanging by his feet from the turret. As they came closer to us the ball gunner looked as if his head was blown off. Then I was busy helping shoot down the other two fighters attacking us for about a minute. Then I saw It Gallagher's ship again gradually drift to the right of our ship and the men started to bail out. I saw four men bail out at this point. Then his ship drifted over to the left rear of us and I lost sight of him.

I was flying ball turret gumner on Lt Stoll's ship. Lt Gallagher was flying right wing on lt Stoll. As our group came out of the clouds the two ships (Lt Stoll and Lt Gallagher) were straggling about three to five hundred yards behind the main group. Just after coming out of the clouds the two ships that were straggling were jumped by three fighters (MR-109's). The first pass made by the fighters hit the ball turret gumner and portions of the left wing of Lt Gallagher's ship with twenty MM cannon fire. The result of this sweep by the enemy fighters was: the ball turret gumner was killed and a small fire broke out in the left wing. Lt Stoll called Lt Gallagher and told him of a fire on the underside of his left wing.

Immediately after this I saw four men bail out, the second of which did not open his parachute as far as the cloud level below us. Lt Gallagher's ship then dropped below and behind and then I saw four more men bail out. Our tail gunner called over the interphone that he had seen eight man bail out. The ball turret man on Lt Gallagher's ship was obviously killed. His turret was blown open and I saw hi body without a head hanging out of the turret. The lower part of the body was caught in the turret keeping the body from falling out.
