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Statement Concerning Missing Aircraft 3173 42-107063, Pilot, 2nd Lt Russell F Reed, O-825978, 603rd Bomb Squadron, 393rd Bomb Group, Hq on Combat Mission to Merseburg, Germany, 2 November 1944.

Shortly after Bombs Away Lt Reed's aircraft was hit in the number two engine by a burst of flak starting a wing fire. The plane pulled out of the element formation and passed under the formation and down out of my view to the left. His wing was burning badly at the time he pulled out of the formation. Several minutes later Lt Bowman's aircraft was hit in the tail section and left wing by 20 mm cannon fire from a German fighter plane. A severe wing fire developed under the left wing and behind the number one engine. Bowman's ship pulled up and over the element formation. He also was burning badly at the time.

I lost sight of both planes for a few minutes. I then saw one of them, at a considerable distance below our formation. I saw four men leave this plane and drop away. Their parachutes did not open while I was watching. I am not certain which of these airplanes the crew members were leaving. It was too far away for me to identify the markings.

It was just after Bomb Bay and we had been attacked by one ~~Fw 190~~ plane. Just after we took care of him, someone called out one of our planes burning at 2:00 o'clock low. I swung my turret and watched him. He passed under our plane and his left wing was all afire. There was no fire in the horizontal stabilizer, which appeared to be intact.

I followed and saw two men bail out but did not see their chutes open. At this time he was away off at 9:00 o'clock and in a glide and then fighters came to come in on our tail and I had to turn to them.

I was flying waist gunner on Lt Wanner's crew. Shortly after
Bomb away we were hit by fighters. Suddenly I noticed the plane on
our right (A for Mike) had a fire in the left wing. Our Co-pilot
was trying to extract him and try to pull him out tail out. The plane
then clipped under our ship, then turned over on its back and went into
an upside down dive. At this point I saw two men bailing out their
chutes opening almost immediately. I saw no one else come out before
the plane disappeared into the clouds.

I was flying Ball Turret on 2d Lt. F Johnson's crew on 2 November 1944. About two or three minutes after bombs away I heard over the interphone that a plane was on fire behind us. I turned around and saw it at 7:00 o'clock. The number two engine was all ablaze. I think the tank was on fire also. My bombardier called me and told me to open my chute and come out. I saw six chutes come out at a level about two thousand feet below us. One chute opened just above the clouds.

Just after I had heard our tail gunner, Sgt. Lazear, report that there was now fighter activity in the squadron before, about 15 minutes after this as we were in a shallow left turn, my bombardier, 1st Lt. Kellman reported that a plane was in a flat spin just to the left of us. I watched it until it went into the clouds but could see nothing.

About 9 minutes later the bombardier called up and reported a plane burning in a flat spin that could have been our right wing. We got our dive and dropped off 57 bombs, one - - even though the last bomb exploded against his fuselage caused a mist of flaming liquid to ensue. I landed in down a considerable distance myself and came up above the plane.


