Statement concerning missing aircraft B17G 43-37889, Pilot, 2nd It James R Mitchell, 0-777761, 601st Bomb Sq, 398th Bomb Group Hv on combat mission to Mannheim, Germany 20 January 1945.

On the second approach to the target at Mennheim, Germany on 20 January 1945 our plane was trailing the squadron by approximately one-fourth mile. I was keeping a sharp watch out of the nose, trying to see the bombs go away when I saw a ship, presumably Lt Mitchell, peel off from the formation and head to the right. I thought it strange, at the moment, because the flak had been light and inaccurate. The ship seemed to be under control, and I could see no signs of fire. I could have been wrong on the latter though because contrails were very dense and heavy. The last I saw of the ship, it was going into the clouds at a normal rate of descent.
